Day 1 – 2 VICTORIA FALLS

Upon arrival at Victoria Falls Airport, guests will be met by a representative and transferred by road to the iconic Victoria Falls Hotel, where they will spend their first 2 nights in Zimbabwe.

The Victoria Falls Hotel, popularly known as 'the grand old lady of the Falls', is situated in the Victoria Falls National Park, a World Heritage Site, and is a member of the exclusive Leading Hotels of the World group. The Edwardian style 5-star hotel, built in 1904, was recently refurbished and now combines the charm of the old with modern conveniences.

Set in lush tropical gardens providing tranquillity and seclusion, world-class service and food and beverage options are available. The Livingstone Room is ideal for fine dining and dancing, the Jungle Junction for breakfast and dinner buffets and ethnic entertainment, and Stanley's Terrace, with its clear view of the Victoria Falls Bridge.

The Victoria Falls is a short 10 minute walk from the hotel grounds on a gentle pathway. Guests will have the opportunity to enjoy a guided tour of the falls. One of the original natural wonders of the world, the Victoria Falls is known locally as 'The Smoke that Thunders'.

The falls are at their highest between April – August and gradually reduce in magnitude, reaching their lowest levels in October – November. In addition to admiring this spectacle, guests can participate in a variety of

optional activities in the Victoria Falls including adrenaline filled bungee jumping or zip lining, or taking it slow on a craft market tour or sundowner cruise.

Overnight at Victoria Falls Hotel – Breakfast.

Day 3 – 5 HWANGE NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast guests depart via road transfer to Victoria Falls Airport before a scenic light aircraft flight to Somalisa Expeditions in Hwange National Park for their next three nights. Flying time is approximately 45 minutes.

Hwange National Park is Zimbabwe's biggest reserve, home to a profusion of wildlife, including giraffe, lion, zebra and approximately 40 000 elephant. It provides sanctuary for all the country's endangered species, including a population of wild dogs thought to be among the most sizeable surviving groups on the continent.

Terrain ranges from desert dunes and savannah lands to rocky outcrops and sparse forests, and visitors have the choice of game drives, guided walks or horseback safaris as a means of experiencing the park and its creatures.

Somalisa Expeditions offers one of the most authentic ways to experience this exceptional wildlife haven. Nestled under an incredible grove of Acacias, along the edge of a seasonal floodplain, the main area includes a lounge and dining area on raised decking which overlooks a small pool, which elephants have become habituated to drinking out of. Add to this, the

waterhole is frequently used as a mud-bath and a popular rendezvous for the elephants. The up-close encounters and photographic opportunities with these majestic animals are endless.

Consisting of 6 elegantly furnished Meru style tents, each one has en-suite bathroom facilities including flush toilets and an outdoor shower. Activities include guided walks led by qualified and passionate guides who will share their knowledge and love of the bush, game drives and night drives.

Wildlife sighting include elephant, kudu, sable antelope, zebra, wildebeest, gemsbok, the rare and endangered roan antelope, buffalo, giraffe, lion, leopard, hyena and many other wildlife species.

Day 6 – 8 MANA POOLS

After a delicious breakfast, guests will be transferred by scheduled light aircraft onto Mana Main Airstrip, where they will be met by a representative of Nyamatusi Camp. Flying time is approximately 90 minutes. Nyamatusi is set in one of the wildest and most remote parts of Africa, on the banks of the Zambezi, one of the world's oldest rivers.

Fully solar-powered and built from all-natural materials it encompasses its wilderness location in the most elegant and comfortable way. Here, a Mana Pools safari plays out against

a sweeping riverine landscape, where epic encounters of the giants that roam this land await.

Consisting of 6 luxury tented suites, with uninterrupted views of the river, the camp invites a relaxing escape to nature. Each romantic guest tent offers complete comfort with air-conditioning, indoor and outdoor shower, private viewing deck, and plunge pool. When not enjoying one of the wide range of inclusive activities, guests can marvel at the incredible sights and sounds of one of Africa's last remaining wilderness hinterlands from the cosy bar or, refreshing pool.

Nyamatusi Camp, lightly translated, means 'wild game'. Here, guests spend their days walking in the footsteps of ancient explorers and tracks of elephants that criss-cross the floodplain. They can watch the drama of nature play out before their eyes on game drives or thrilling canoeing safaris. Fishing on the Zambezi River (catch and release only) and birding safaris are highlights here. All these activities are included in this stay and led by qualified and passionate guides, keen to share their knowledge and love of the bush.

Overnight at Nyamatusi Camp – Fully Inclusive.

Day 9 DEPARTURE

After an early morning activity, guests will be transferred by scheduled light aircraft to Harare International Airport in time for their onward journey. Flying time is approximately 90 minutes.
