

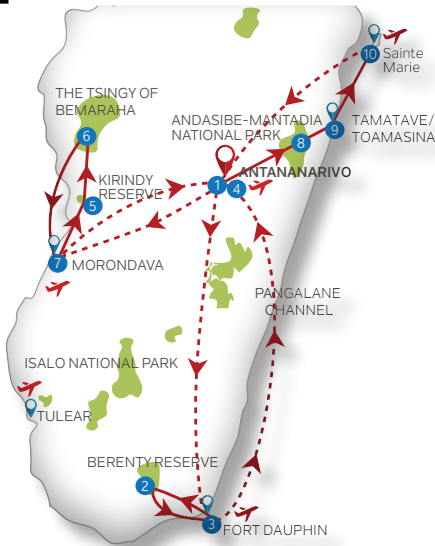

Day 1
ANTANANARIVO
Guests are welcomed on arrival by their guide and transferred to Palissandre Hotel, which is located on a hillside in the heart of the city.
Overnight at Palissandre Hotel – Dinner.

Day 2
BERENTY RESERVE
After breakfast, guests are transferred to the airport for a scheduled flight to Fort Dauphin. Here, a hotel representative will meet and transfer them by road to the Berenty Reserve. Guests can enjoy dinner at the lodge.
Overnight at Berenty Lodge – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 3
FORT DAUPHIN
Following breakfast guests can join their guide and begin to exploring the Berenty Reserve. In the afternoon guests will be transferred by road to Fort Dauphin, passing through the sisal plantations and through the villages of Anosy. Guests will arrive at the hotel La Croix du Sud, which is located in the historic centre of Fort Dauphin. Guests can enjoy dinner at the hotel restaurant.
Overnight at Croix Du Sud – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 4
ANTANANARIVO
Guests can spend their morning at leisure. They can choose between a variety of activities provided by the hotel or they can explore Fort Dauphin before being transferred to the airport for a scheduled flight to Antananarivo. If time

permits, guests can stop at the craft market in Antananarivo. Dinner will be served at the restaurant.
Overnight at Palissandre Hotel – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 5
KIRINDY RESERVE
After breakfast guests are transferred to the airport, where they will board their flight to Morondava. Guests will be met by their guide with a 4WD, and travel through the famous Avenue of Baobabs to reach the Kirindy Reserve. Guests are encouraged to go for an evening walk in search of the active night wildlife, before returning to the hotel for dinner.
Overnight at Relais Du Kirindy - Breakfast and dinner.

Day 6
BEKOPAKA
After breakfast, guests can go for a 2 hour walk in the reserve where they can expect to spot various different species of lemurs and endemic reptiles, before starting their journey to Bekopaka. After crossing the Tsiribihina River, guests can enjoy lunch in Belo (own account), before continuing the long drive to the ferry, which crosses the Manambolo River. Guests will arrive in Bekopaka in late the afternoon. Dinner will be served at the hotel.
Overnight at Soleil des Tsingy – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 7
TSINGY DE BEMARAHA NATIONAL PARK
After an early breakfast, guests are taken by their guide and porter into the Tsingy De

Bemaraha National Park to explore for the day. . Guests enjoy a picnic lunch while in the reserve.
Overnight at Soleil des Tsingy – Breakfast, picnic lunch, and dinner.

Day 8
MORONDAVA
Following breakfast, guests head back to Morondava, crossing back over the Manambolo and Tsiribihina Rivers. Once at the hotel, guests can settle in with a breathtaking view overlooking the ocean, after which dinner will be served at the restaurant.
Overnight at Palissandre Côte Ouest - Breakfast and dinner.

Day 9
ANDASIBE
After breakfast, guests are transferred to Morondava Airport for a scheduled flight to Antananarivo, where they will be met by a guide and depart for Andasibe. They will leave the Highlands, passing through the escarpment of the Mandraka.

Guests should arrive in Andasibe in the late afternoon, and are encouraged to enjoy a night walk in the Mitsinjo Communitary Reserve (if time allows).
Overnight at Vakona Forest Lodge – Breakfast and dinner.

Day 10
TAMATAVE
Today guests can go hiking in the Analamazaotra National Park, only 5km away, to discover rare and endemic species of fauna and flora. The tour then continues eastward

to Tamatave (Toamasina) on the east coast of Madagascar. Guests can enjoy lunch which will be served en route.
Overnight at Calypso Hotel – Breakfast, picnic lunch, and dinner.

Day 11-13
SAINTE MARIE
After breakfast at the hotel, early departure for Mahambo and boat transfer to Sainte Marie. Guests will be met by a hotel representative upon arrival at Sainte Marie, which is described as a quiet and peaceful island with natural white sand beaches and coconut studded palm trees.

Sainte Marie is nothing less than a little piece of paradise in the Indian Ocean. Guests can spend the next 2 days at leisure, choosing from a variety of activities provided by the resort (for own account). Guests are encouraged to revel in the scenes and sights of the island.

Guests can stop to enjoy lunch or a refreshment at any one of the small restaurants or hotels located along the way (for own account).
Overnight at Princesse Bora Lodge – Breakfast and dinner.

DAY 14
DEPARTURE
After breakfast, guests are transferred to the airport by the hotel for a scheduled flight to Antananarivo.
