

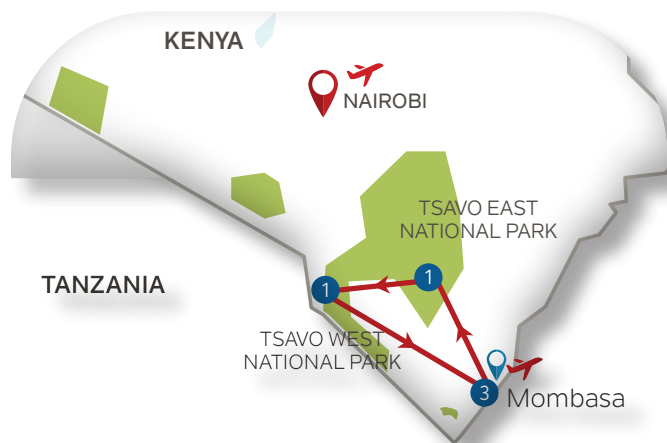

# Kenya and Beach Safari

## Highlights

**Day 1**  
**TSAVO EAST**  
Early pick up from Moi Airport or from the beach hotel and drive over to Tsavo East. Guests arrive for lunch at the lodge and then enjoy an afternoon game drive in Tsavo East National Park.

Tsavo East is predominantly flat, dry plains, and supports a vast number of wildlife, including the famous Tsavo lions, wild dog, cheetah and leopard. Guests then return to enjoy dinner at the lodge.  
**Overnight at Satao Camp / Ashnil Aruba Lodge - Breakfast, lunch and dinner.**

**Day 2**  
**TSAVO WEST**  
Guests enjoy an early breakfast at the lodge and then check-out. They depart with picnic lunch boxes from the lodge and drive over to the Tsavo West National Park, where they will enjoy a game drive and visit to Mzima Springs.

The Tsavo West National Park has more mountainous terrain than the east side, with more rainfall resulting in swamp areas, such as the Mzima Springs. Guests arrive at camp in the late evening and enjoy night game drive.  
**Severin Camp / Voyager Ziwani Camp Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 3**  
**MOMBASA**  
Guests enjoy an early morning walking safari followed by breakfast at the camp. After breakfast, they will transfer back to Mombasa with picnic lunch boxes from the camp, and are dropped off at the beach hotel late in the afternoon.

The Voyager Beach Resort is located a short distance outside of Mombasa, overlooking Nyali beach. There are a variety of facilities and activities available to keep everyone entertained. Guests can choose between the 3 restaurants to enjoy their dinner.  
**Overnight at Voyager Beach Resort – Dinner.**

**Day 4**  
**MOMBASA**  
In the morning, guests depart for a Mombasa city tour and shopping excursion, where they will see the ivory tusks which mark the gateway to Mombasa, walk around the historic Fort Jesus Museum, experience the sights and smells of the city food and spice market, view the Likoni Channel, and take in the local talent at the Akamba wood carving factory.

Later, guests return to the hotel and spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure.  
**Overnight at Voyager Beach Resort Breakfast and dinner.**

**Day 5**  
**MOMBASA**  
Guests are picked up from their hotel and transferred to the Wasini Jetty for a leisurely cruise on their own spacious wooden dhow.

On deck, they can relax on big, comfortable pillows. Coffee, tea and snacks are served on board. Guests can enjoy dolphin spotting, and

if they are lucky enough, the dolphins may join them for a swim in the marine park.

Head out to Kisite Marine Park where guests can snorkel, before sailing back to Wasini Island for lunch at Coral Spirit Restaurant.

After lunch guests can opt to visit Wasini Village and take a stroll through the island and discover the Swahili culture, visiting the beautiful coral garden and the mangrove forest. Guests then board the dhow and sail into the sunset, with a glass of wine. They are then transferred back to their beach hotel.  
**Overnight at Voyager Beach Resort - Breakfast and Dinner.**

**Day 6**  
**DEPARTURE**  
Guests are collected from their beach hotel and transferred to Moi International Airport for their flight.  
**Breakfast.**
